The three designers started creating their own necklacs in the early 1980s. Their designs are not only based on formal education in jewelry design, beeding and techniques, which they completed in Switzerland, the United States and England. They are mainly a product of insight, observation and appreciation of jewelry in the Arabian Peninsula, the Middle East and the Far East.

In the eighties, the three Alireza women-artists featured their work in annual charity bazaars in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, and in privately sponsored exhibits in the Kingdom and in California, USA.
