Imitating Men

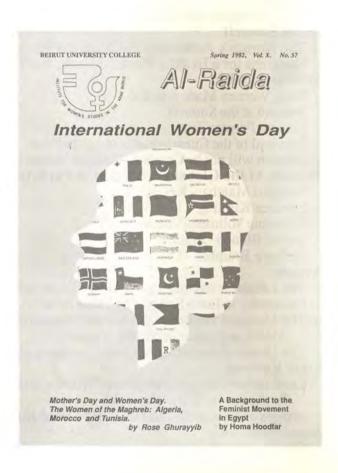
